DESCRIPTION

The Kansas Food Bank provides nutritious food to neighbors experiencing food insecurity in 85 counties in Kansas. Operations team members play a vital role in fulfilling the organization's goals on a daily basis. The Duties of the CDL Rural Delivery Driver position are as follows:

- Safe handling of all warehouse equipment including but not limited to pallet jacks, hand dollies, and forklifts, and to avoid personal injury to self, others and damage to product, equipment, or facility.
- Maintain a clean, orderly and safe work area at all times including warehouse grounds, equipment, trucks, vans and facility.
- Load and unload all types of transportation equipment (trucks vans cars etc.).
- Make pickup and deliveries in a timely manner as assigned, follow all traffic laws and operate KFB equipment in the safest manner possible. Always driving in a courteous manner.
- Demonstrate professionalism and speak respectfully when interacting with staff, volunteers, donors, and the general public.
- Other duties as assigned.
